

### Campus Dejvice

The heart of CTU in Prague is on the Dejvice campus. The university is part of the city, so do not look for any fence dividing the campus off from the surroundings. Here you will find the Rectorate and the International Office, Masarykova Dorm and the International Student Club, the Student House Canteens, which we call menzas, [16] the National Technical Library. The most of the international students are accommodated in the Masarykova Dorm or in Strahov Dorm. In both locations you will find and office of the International Student Club which means friends, fun and help.

If you want to eat fast food, go to Vítězné náměstí (KFC, Boulevard). If you are looking for a restau--rant, try some in Jugoslávských partyzánů Street (U Topolů). The nearest supermarkets are Albert (Československé armády 826), Kaufland (Juliska -Tram station Podbaba) and Billa (next to Dejvická Tram station). If you need some medicine there are several pharmacies, including a 24-hour pharmacy on Vítězné nám., also known in English as the Round Square. When you need a bank, more shopping or more restaurants, start at Vítězné náměstí, go up in the direction towards Hradčanská and you will soon find what you are looking for.


#### **Prescriptions**





# **Public transport plan**




## ALBERTOV Faculty of Mechanical Engineering,
